On www.beachsheet.eu, a site of Beach Hot, we use cookies. A cookie is a small file containing pages of this site and it contains Flash applications is transmitted and stored by your browser on your hard drive of your computer. The stored information can be sent back to our servers when you visit. This cookie statement we explain what cookies are placed and with what objectives.

Remember settings

We use cookies to store your settings and preferences, so that we do not always need to ask here. It involves the following settings and preferences:

- An opportunity to remain logged;
- The realization of a shopping cart (shopping cart) for our online store;
- · Remember to which cookies you have consented;

You can block these cookies via your browser, but you must always re-enter these preferences.

Function of the website

We use cookies to make our website work properly. These functional cookies are used only for this purpose. In this way we do the following:

- Visual settings (text size, colors, etc.);
- Your name, email address and the like so that you do not need to fill in;
- Your language preferenc;
- Requests to participate in surveys or newsletters;
- To avoid you will see an add to often.

You can block these cookies via your browser, but this may be the performance of our website affect negatively.

Social media buttons

On our website buttons are included to Web pages to promote and share on social networks, namely Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, Google+, and these buttons places cookies.

These buttons work through snippets of code from these social networks themselves originate. We have no influence. Please read the privacy statements of these networks (which can change frequently) to read what they do with the (personal) data they obtain through these cookies.

The information gathered by these networks, is transferred to the United States, and there stored on servers. The companies behind these networks pose to adhere to the Safe Harbor principles and are affiliated with the Safe Harbor program of the US Department of Commerce. This means that there is an adequate level of protection for the processing of any personal data.

Tracking and profiles

We use so-called tracking cookies to build a profile about you. This tracking cookie may also be requested when you visit another website from our network. This allows us to find out that you've been on this other website (s) next to this website. The accumulated about you profile is not linked to your name, address, e-mail and the like as known to us, but only serves ads to tune in to your profile so they are relevant as possible for you.
